Fur Harvesters Auction Inc. is pleased to announce the results of our May 27th, 2007 Auction. A large and diverse crowd of buyers from all major markets were in attendance. Raccoons were the main attraction of the auction; with larger sized and heavier sections selling extremely well. Strong support on the raccoons came from Greece, China, Italy and Turkey. Sable prices rose to the highest levels this season with darker colours selling at a premium, while fisher showed strong interest and sold at current market conditions. Beaver sold at market levels, with the larger sizes having some difficulty in the commercial shearing types. Smaller size beaver sold well, with high clearances. Muskrats continue to struggle due to the fact that last year price levels were extremely high. Many customers had difficulty moving their inventory at last year's levels. Lynx and bobcats sold at high levels with the off coloured bellies having some price reductions over last year. Coyotes showed some resistance as the trim trade was not active at this time. With an early start to winter, interest will pick up on this article.
