

SALE RESULTS – June 21st, 2011

Fur Harvesters Auction Inc.'s final sale of the season, despite smaller quantities and a later collection of goods, produced results that were positive for those species where demand was apparent. All international markets were represented.

Beaver and otter were firm to March levels, and small collections of arctic fox and mink were 100% sold. Muskrat continued to shine, selling 100% at a ten dollar average for first section goods. Demand was selective on lynx and lynx cats, but where sold, the better goods continued to attract high prices. Demand was very selective for sable, fisher, raccoon and coyote. Red fox continued to sell well, and prices for the better qualities of arctic wolves and wolverines advanced significantly over March 2011.
