Ranch mink markets seem to be ever changing, due to consumer trends which effect sales on certain types of merchandise. Our March 20th – 22nd auction showed strength on short medium nap lengths, due to an active trim trade driven by Turkey and Greece. Stepping into our May 26th – 28th auction the Turkish trim trade was not active, resulting in reduced price levels on certain nap lengths. China once again was a major player on consuming merchandise, but only at conservative levels, as cash flow seems to be a problem at this time. Korea showed support on better quality grades, colours and clarities on pale and x-pale short nap females.
